- ii. Nicole Munson (Col. Of Education and Human Development Senator) & Clarissa Clarke (Communications Director) met with Dr. Pomerantz about increased printing costs:
Highlights:
 - last year the printing costs were 81,000\$ over for the amount of what was received for printing for the students. Budget costs increased economic struggle. Administration had to choose between charging more for the printing or closing the labs earlier. Average printing costs for most universities in VA: 1 pg black & white is 8 c, others were 12 or 15 c, UVA is eliminating computer labs altogether.
 - No answer was given regarding the lack of notification to the students.
 - Currently checking with academic affairs about how to transfer printing money to students who are actually planning on using it from those who do not use it.
